**EMS MEDICATION RECERTIFICATION - JUNE 22, 2018**

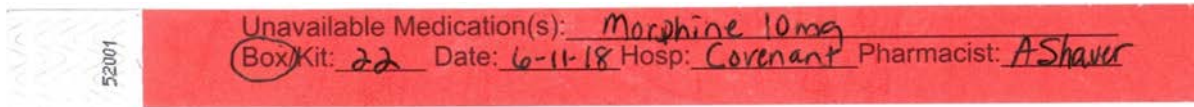

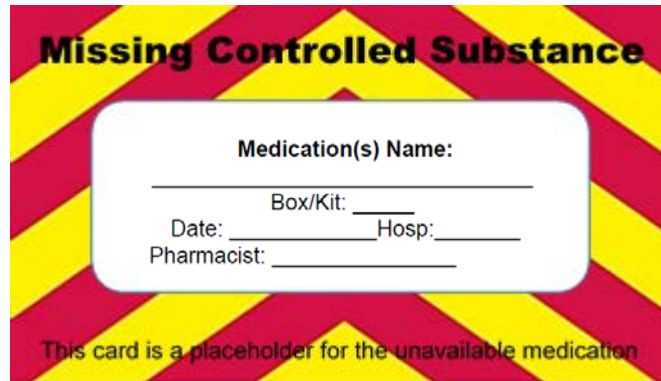
All Pharmacies:

EMS medication recertification is on June 22, 2018. There are no changes to the boxes or kits this time. However, there are a couple changes to how we will handle medication shortages:

1. Instead of the Medication Alert stickers, we will use a red band attached to the handle of any box/kit that is missing a medication due to shortage. More than one medication can be listed on these bands and they are to be removed once the pharmacy has that medication back in stock.



2. When a controlled substance (diazepam, fentanyl, morphine, ketamine, etc.) is not available, there will be a "Placeholder" card put into the controlled substances kit in addition to the red band on the handle. This will hopefully alleviate some confusion and ensure that a pharmacist is initialing when a medication has not been restocked due to shortage. Please do not remove these cards. The pharmacist will remove them when they have the medication available. For these, there is one card per medication or vial that is missing.



Finally, we will no longer be supplying the pharmacies warning stickers to place on the dextrose 10%. We have been using the D10 for a quite a while now and should no longer need to mark these prominently. Please remember to always read the label before giving any fluid or medication.

As always, please take the boxes and kits to a participating pharmacy beginning around 7:00AM on Friday.
