SUBJECT: SVMCA Medication Box Recertification – February 26, 2010

The SVMCA EMS Medication Box Recertification will take place the morning of February 26<sup>th</sup>, 2010. The following changes will occur:

1. A stopcock will be added and placed in the bottom of the box. This is to help facilitate saline flushes during Adenosine administration. Additionally, this will help with the dilution of medications for pediatrics.
2. Morphine Sulfate is no longer being manufactured as a pre-filled 10 mg in 10 ml syringe. It will now be supplied as a 10 mg in 1 ml Carpuject. Two of these will be supplied in each box. Providers should be very cautious as the Diazepam and Morphine will look very similar.  
**READ THE LABELS!**
3. An additional 19, 21, & 23 gauge safety needle will be added. There will now be 3 of each.
4. There are no changes to the IV Kit.
