PHARMACY RECERTIFICATION - February 2012 SUBJECT:

The Greater Bay Area EMS Medication System will be recertifying all EMS drug boxes and kits on February 24, 2012. All boxes and bags will need to be turned into a participating pharmacy for recertification.

## **CHANGES**

Ondansetron will no longer be stocked in the ALS mini-kit. This is due to continued industry-wide shortages. The Pharmacy and Therapeutics Committee considered switching to Oral Disintegrating Tablet (ODT) in the kits; however these are also in short supply. Please continue to be diligent in not using this medication prophylactically.

Furosemide vials will decrease to just one in the box. This change is due both to shortage and furosemide's questionable effectiveness in treating CHF in the pre-hospital setting. Remember, furosemide is now a post-radio contact medication.

Diazepam continues to be difficult for the hospitals to obtain. For now, instead of replacing vials that would expire mid-recertification, our pharmacies will be leaving vials in the box until they actually expire. Boxes with diazepam that expires before the end of June 2012 will have an "ALERT" sticker on the top of the box with an expiration date of the diazepam. This will hopefully hold us over until more shipments of diazepam are received. When using diazepam in the field, please try to use the oldest vial in the box.
