SUBJECT: MEDICAL CONTROL BOARD – ALS REPRESENTATIVE OPENING

The Saginaw Valley Medical Control Authority (SVMCA) – Medical Control Board (MCB) has an immediate opening for an ALS Representative.

DESCRIPTION

The SVMCA MCB is primary advisory body for the Medical Control Authority. Decisions regarding SVMCA policy and protocols are adopted and approved by the MCB before being submitted to the Michigan Department of Public Health (MDCH) for approval and implementation. Additionally, the MCB routinely addresses critical issues occurring within the SVMCA that affect patient care.

The Board consists of representatives from each member hospital, the Chair from each standing committee within the SVMCA, the Director of each Central Dispatch, Emergency Managers from each County, a licensed representative from each level of EMS care (MFR, EMT, EMT-P), and the Medical Director.

The ALS Representative of the SVMCA MCB provides current field perspective from the view of an ALS provider to the Board membership. This is not an agency representative position and the individual is not expected to represent their agency; rather their cohorts. Additionally, the ALS Representative votes on all items that come before the MCB for adoption/approval.

QUALIFICATIONS

The ALS Representative must be an active SVMCA EMT-P. There is no minimum experience level however a full-time equivalent field paramedic is preferred.

REQUIREMENTS

The ALS Representative must participate in a majority of regularly scheduled MCB meetings. These occur typically on the third Friday of each month at 09:00 am and are held at the SVMCA offices. Special meetings are rare but nonetheless a possibility. This position also receives no reimbursement from the SVMCA. The representative's agency may or may not choose compensate for time/mileage.

APPLICATION
