REGION 3 MCA Network Paramedic Scholarship

All Region 3 EMS Providers:

Emergency Medical Services in Michigan is currently experiencing severe shortages in medical professionals trained to respond to medical emergencies in the pre-hospital setting. Recognizing this, the Region 3 MCA Network, through a grant from the MDHHS Bureau of EMS, Trauma, and Preparedness, has established a 2018 Paramedic Scholarship Program.

Thirty \$2,000 scholarships are available to EMTs currently within any of the Region 3 counties. Payment of the scholarship is at the beginning of the scheduled class and made directly to the Paramedic Program that the recipient chooses.

Eligibility Requirements

- Must be a currently licensed EMT or AEMT and eligible to become Nationally Registered under the NREMT.
- Cannot have current MCA disciplinary action or a criminal record that would make you ineligible to hold a Michigan Paramedic License.
- Currently live or work in any of the 12 Region 3 counties.
- Enroll, and be accepted into a State of Michigan approved paramedic program that begins before September 30, 2018.

Application Process

- Fill out and submit an electronic application **no later than July 31, 2018**.
- Applications are reviewed and scholarships awarded by the Region 3 MCA Network Planning Board.
- All scholarship applicants will be advised of their status no later than August 31, 2018.

The number of scholarships is limited to thirty. In the event that more applications are received than scholarships available, the Region 3 MCA Network Planning Board will determine awardees based on information contained in the applications.
